October is time to show your support of local access to breast cancer screening!

One in eight women in the U.S. will be diagnosed with breast cancer at some point in their lives. This includes mothers, daughters, friends and neighbors right here in our community.

October is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month. We invite you to join us in raising awareness of and increasing access to breast cancer screenings. Once again, Kachemak Bay Family Planning Clinic is providing pink flags for businesses and households around our community. The community-wide display of flags will serve as a reminder to access preventive care and will emphasize the importance of breast health and preventative screening services. The funds raised provide crucial sustainability, ensuring continuance of KBFPFC programs that offer breast cancer screening services and breast health education.

Through our Community Health Outreach Program, we connect with women door-to-door and help them eliminate barriers to screening such as cost or transportation. As a provider for the Alaska Breast and Cervical Health Check program, **we offer no-cost annual exams, clinical breast exams, mammograms and diagnostic services** to those who qualify. Join us in promoting Project Wellness, with an emphasis on developing a life-long habit of annual screening visits. **KBFPFC provides these valuable services to women regardless of their ability to pay.**

Throughout the month of October, local businesses, organizations, and homes will display our flags in two shades of pink.
